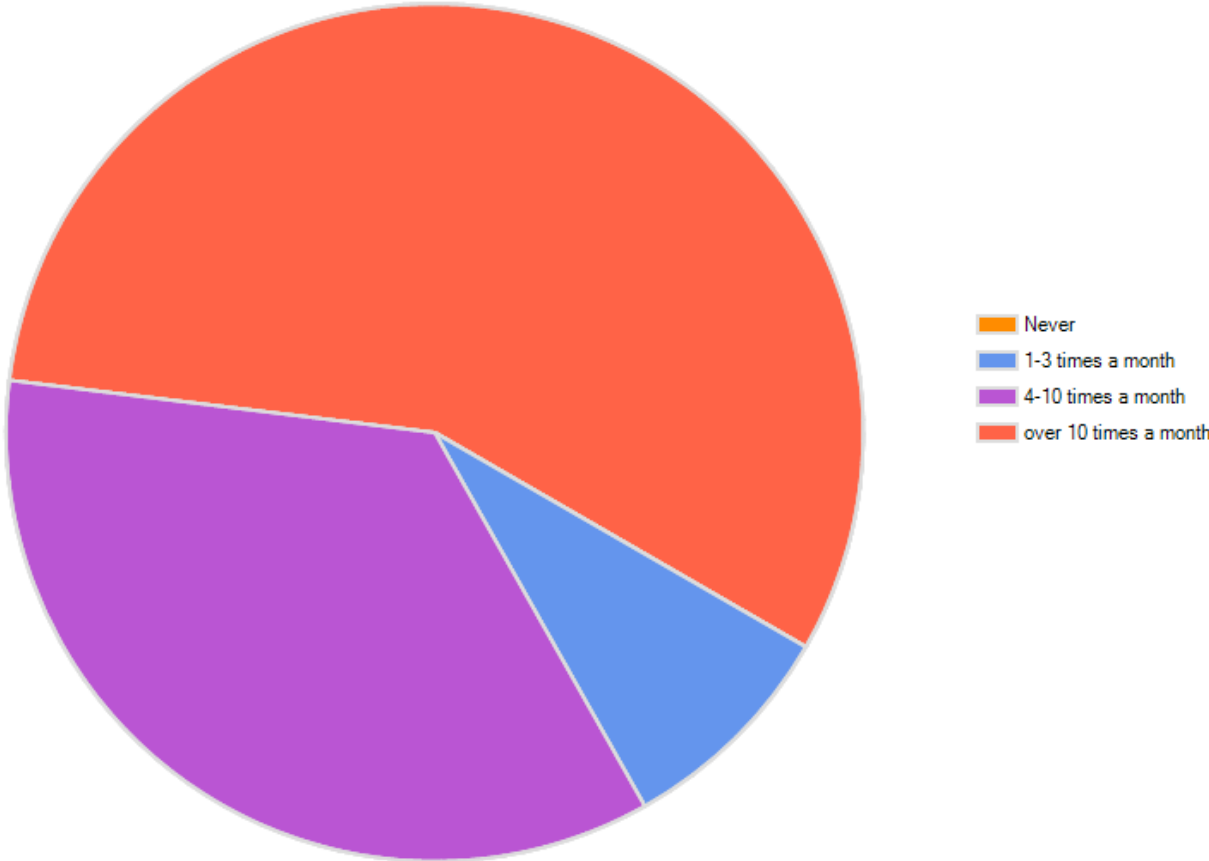




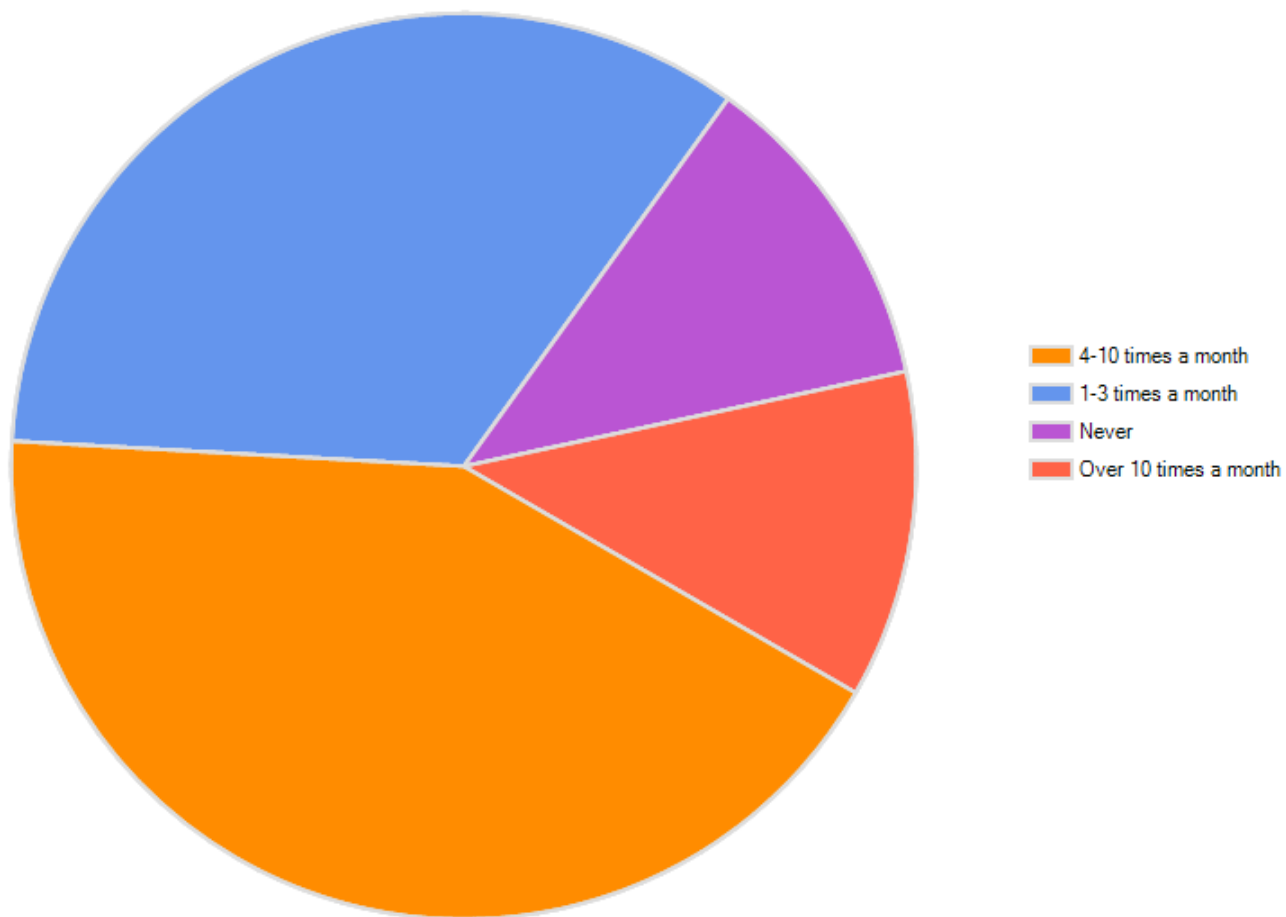
**Bay View Neighborhood Association's Economic Development Survey 2011 Results**

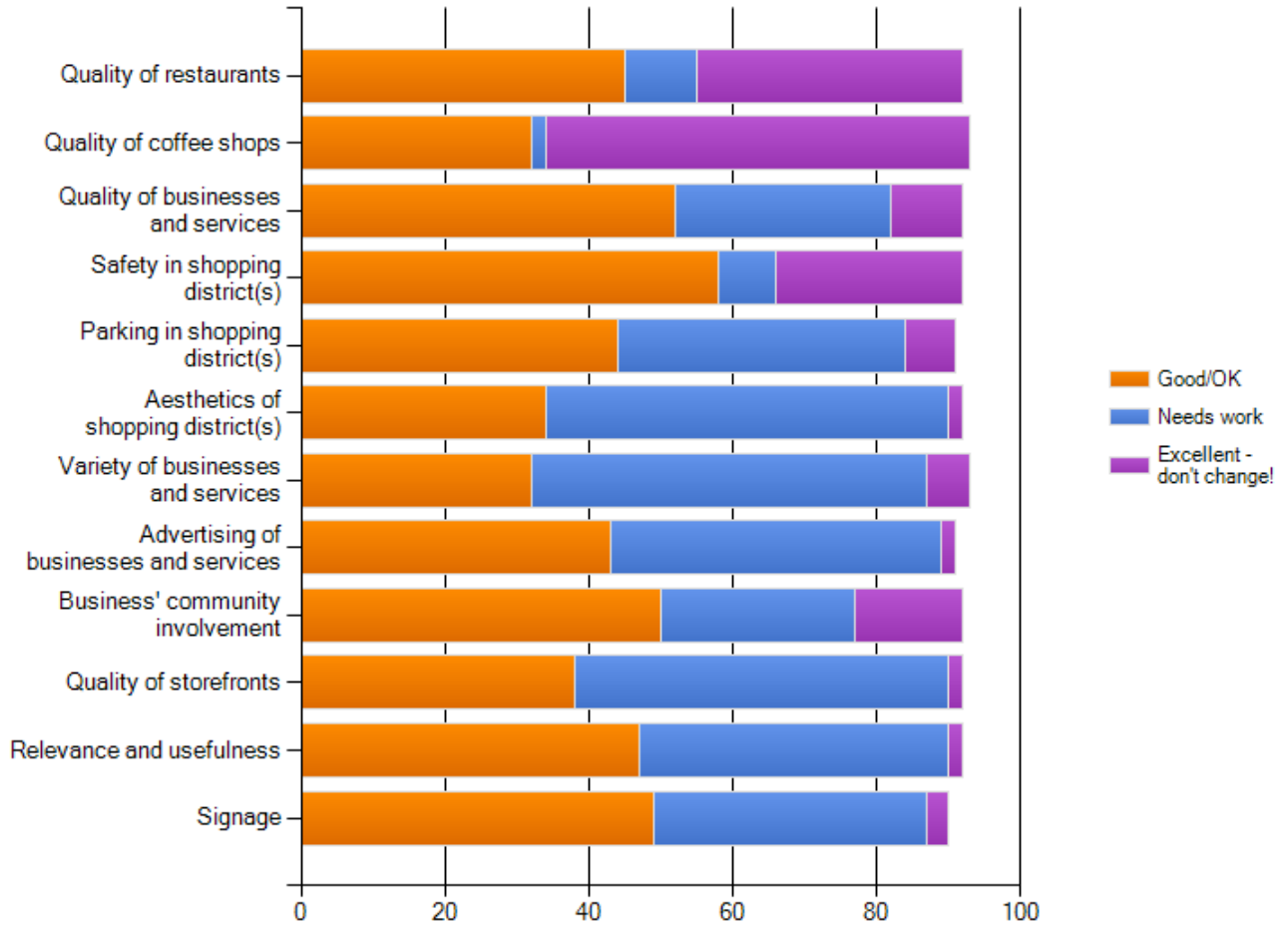
**How often do you visit Bay View businesses? (Restaurants and coffee shops included.)**



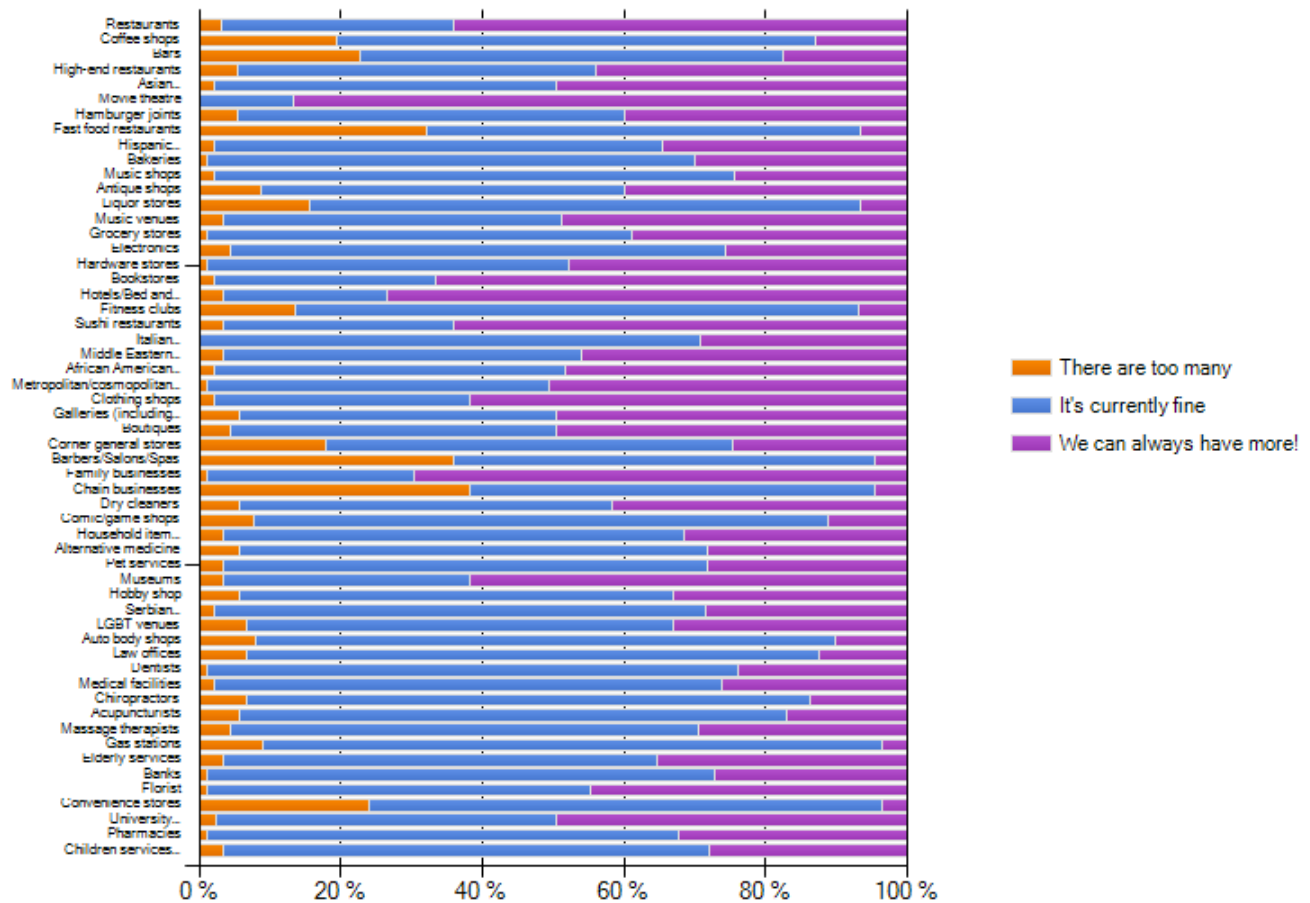
How often do you shop in Bay View? (Restaurants and coffee shops excluded, unless you're buying merchandise from there.)

## Tell us what types of businesses you'd like to see more of or less of in Bay View.



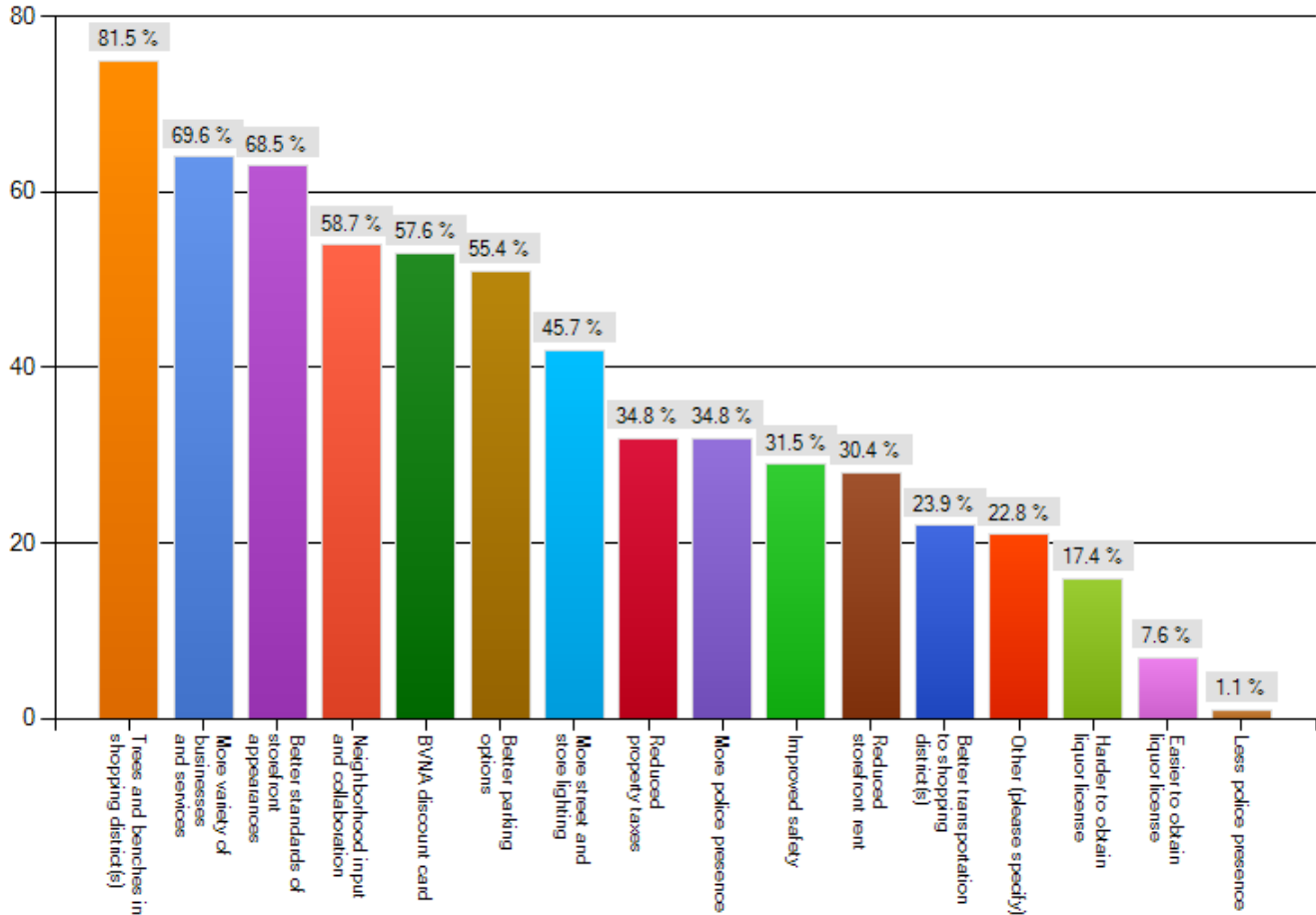
“Other” responses to the question, “Tell us what types of businesses you'd like to see more of or less of in Bay View.” Responses are as they appeared in the results (not proofed).
